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ABSTRACT

This dissertation is the study of FAO's activities in Myanmar. Myanmar is a member of United Nations (UN). As a member country, Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) has undertaken the development of agriculture, forestry, livestock and fisheries sectors. The aim of this dissertation is to study the cooperation between FAO and Government of Myanmar in these sectors from 1990 to 2000. Myanmar has benefited from FAO's technical assistance in agriculture, forestry, livestock and fisheries development with this cooperation. During 1990-2000, FAO assisted nine projects in agriculture, eight projects in forestry and six projects in livestock and fisheries. FAO implemented these projects in the regions of Dry Zone, Ayeyawady Delta, Shan State, and Eastern and Western Border Area.

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
