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ABSTRACT

The aim and objective of writing this Dissertation is to present that the State had taught the Management, Economics, Sociology and Political Science Subjects to the government officials in order to promote their capabilities and to become efficient officials. Furthermore this Dissertation presents that the physical, intellectual and moral characters will be improved and the good officials will be bred by attending the training given by CICS (Phaunggyi). This Dissertation described the founding of the Central Civil Service Training School (CCSTS) Phaunggyi from 1965 to 2005 with the span of forty years. The Faculty of Management assists in the opening of training courses successfully and the Faculty of Training is considered as a main task in the development of human resources. The drafting of laws concerning with the CICS (Phaunggyi), the Organization of the Institute, the pattern of management, the training and teaching of the trainees by opening various courses, the construction of buildings that are required in giving the trainings, the construction of training grounds, the division of faculties according to the subject in order to be convenient in teaching, the compilation of curriculum, the holding of examination, the awarding of prizes and the activities of agriculture, livestock breeding and research for the all round development of the trainees are described in this Dissertation.

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
