## **ABSTRACT**

This dissertation is mainly an attempt to provide missing link of cultural phases in Myanmar prehistoric context such as Late Palaeolithic, Mesolithic and Neolithic period. Moegyobyin site is situated in Salingyi Township, Sagaing Region. Varieties of material remains were found at Moegyobyin site. They are many kinds of stone implements, potsherds, beads, teeth of animals, fragments of bone and stone slabs about a man's height without inscription and scripture. There are surface finds from Wetsoekone near Moegyobyin village. Especially, many kinds of stone implements are found from this site. The stone implements are made with different rock types and used for different purposes. Moreover, cultural identification on the evidences of Moegyobyin site is compared with those of other prehistoric sites of Middle Myanmar. This dissertation expects to reconstruct the culture of Moegyobyin site.
